## About SPARCS

Sustainable energy Positive & zero cARbon Communities demonstrates and validates technically and socioeconomically viable and replicable, innovative solutions for rolling out smart, integrated positive energy systems for the transition to a citizen centred zero carbon & resource efficient economy. SPARCS facilitates the participation of buildings to the energy market enabling new services and a virtual power plant concept, creating VirtualPositiveEnergy communities as energy democratic playground (positive energy districts can exchange energy with energy entities located outside the district). Seven cities will demonstrate 100+ actions turning buildings, blocks, and districts into energy prosumers. Impacts span economic growth, improved quality of life, and environmental benefits towards the EC policy framework for climate and energy, the SET plan and UN Sustainable Development goals. SPARCS co-creation brings together citizens, companies, research organizations, city planning and decision making entities, transforming cities to carbon-free inclusive communities. Lighthouse cities Espoo (FI) and Leipzig (DE) implement large demonstrations. Fellow cities Reykjavik (IS), Maia (PT), Lviv (UA), Kifissia (EL) and Kladno (CZ) prepare replication with hands-on feasibility studies. SPARCS identifies bankable actions to accelerate market uptake, pioneers innovative, exploitable governance and business models boosting the transformation processes, joint procurement procedures and citizen engaging mechanisms in an overarching city planning instrument toward the bold City Vision 2050. SPARCS engages 30 partners from 8 EU Member States (FI, DE, PT, CY, EL, BE, CZ, IT) and 2 non-EU countries (UA, IS), representing key stakeholders within the value chain of urban challenges and smart, sustainable cities bringing together three distinct but also overlapping knowledge areas: (i) City Energy Systems, (ii) ICT and Interoperability, (iii) Business Innovation and Market Knowledge.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This deliverable, a list of events, is a working document that includes all relevant workshops, seminars, webinars, conferences etc. for SPARCS partners to pay attention to and coordinate their attendance and participation. The current deliverable D8.12 is an updated version of D8.11, representing the current state of play of the list of events.

In addition, in the narrative part of the deliverable we provide an overview of the attendance at events identified in the event tracking tool and beyond to showcase the effectiveness of the tool.

## 2. DESCRIPTION OF LIST OF EVENTS

---

The list of events focuses on events tracked by all consortium partners and includes relevant H2020 SCC1 and other applicable Smart Cities\Urban Planning\Urban Transformation focused events taking place in Europe. It is designed to enable the workflow of event identification and attendance.

The list of events to attend is managed by GOPA Com. with help from all WP8 and WP6 partners who are screening all relevant events Europe-wide. All tracked events are being analysed based on the audiences, scope and presentation type, thus allowing for a decision on how to be present at the event. The identified events are evaluated against their relevance in terms of target audiences, visibility potential and reach. The consortium partners who attend the event will follow with reporting and evaluation such as website article about the participation or sharing of knowledge presentation at the internal communications meetings.

The list of events to attend is built into an interactive working document that includes the following indicators which were revised in comparison with the previous version.

- Name of the event
- Organiser of the event
- Link to the event
- Start and end date
- Year
- Country
- City
- Topic
- Event type

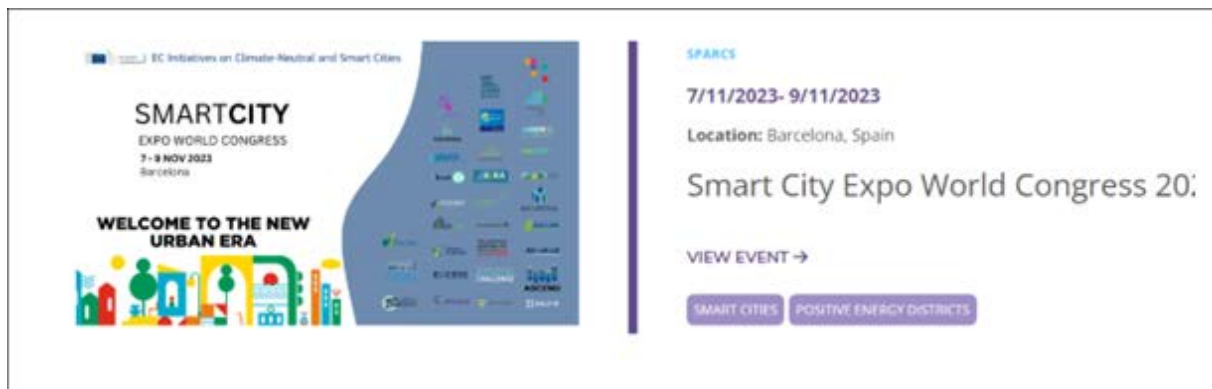
While the previous version of this deliverable included information indicating which partners were planning to attend the event, in the course of work, it became clear that this feature consistently used by the consortium. As a result, it was removed. Instead, partners are currently reporting about their event participation via other tools (internal timeline templates, WP6 calls) and by providing information for the SPARCS website.

A simplified form of elements mentioned above is also reflected online on the SPARCS website, displaying usually:

- Name of the event
- Location of the event
- Start and end date
- Link to the event
- Registration deadline

By doing this, we are ensuring wider targeted dissemination of closely related initiatives, thus boarding the multipliers reach.

WP8 leader GOPA Com. is requesting input on upcoming and past events from SPARCS partners during the monthly WP6 and WP8 coordination call or during the WP6 coordination calls, thus allowing the list of events to be updated regularly. The tracking tool of events is added as appendix to this document.

### 3. LIST OF EVENTS TO ATTEND

The working document - the list of events is uploaded and updated monthly on in the scope of the work in WP8. GOPA Com tracks relevant events SPARCS objectives, including other H2020 projects, EU initiatives, EU institutions, and international events. To date, the document provides an overview of events identified in 2021, 2022 and 2023 as well as identified potential events upcoming in 2024. The documents also contain information about past events starting from 2019 to provide a comprehensive overview.

## 3.1 Summary of past events

---

Since the start of the project in 2019, SPARCS consortium partners have communicated and disseminated about SPARCS projects, its work and demonstrations in the seven cities during events on topics such as smart city communities, PED, stakeholder engagement and sustainable city development.

This is a highlight of some of the events that SPARCS partners attended during the period of January 2022 and November 2023, encompassing the period since the last update of this deliverable in December 2021.

### 3.1.1 Year 2022

On February 16-17, 2022, the city of Kifissia took part in The AGORA Strategic Dialogue, part of JPI Urban Europe's DUT program. The city of Kifissia was part of a workshop titled "Identifying the crossroads between urban circularity, mobility, and energy", where it has been given the opportunity to present the work and the progress that has been made in terms of urban transformation in the Municipality of Kifissia.

SPARCS hosted the webinar "Start-up Competition from A to Z: Key Learnings and Success Factors," on April 21, 2022. The event featured insights from KONE and the City of Leipzig on co-innovation challenges and success ingredients within SPARCS, followed by Fraunhofer IAO sharing insights on replicating smart city competitions in other urban areas.

The SPARCS City Forum, held online on May 16th, 2022, focused on 'Urban Data Platform: Experiences from Project Cities Leipzig and Maia,' aiming to share insights and experiences for a comprehensive understanding of this concept. Organized by Fraunhofer, the event featured experts from the Cities of Leipzig and Maia, drawing around 30 project participants and encompassing presentations, a panel discussion, and Q&A sessions to explore Leipzig's Urban Data Platform development, use cases, challenges, and insights into Maia's implementation status.

During the Green Week 2022, SPARCS and POCITYF hosted jointly an online webinar on 31 May, 2022 on the topic of "Digital solutions in supporting cities' energy transition to climate neutrality". Focused on showcasing implemented solutions across various cities involved in the H2020 projects, the event aimed to emphasize the role of digital solutions in achieving climate neutrality, highlighting examples from Lighthouse and Fellow cities to address the pressing challenges posed by urban CO2 emissions and energy consumption, aligning with Europe's goals for a resource-efficient and climate-neutral future by 2050.

SPARCS and Smart Otaniemi jointly hosted a successful webinar on April 7th, 2022 focusing on e-mobility and the pivotal role of charging infrastructure in regional growth. The webinar offered valuable insights into replicating lessons from the Sello shopping centre to benefit other municipalities, setting a positive tone for potential future collaborations between SPARCS and Smart Otaniemi.

The Eurocities 2022 conference, held in Espoo from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> June, provided an opportunity to present SPARCS at a large-scale international conference with a

large visitor base. The important themes of the event included youth participation, joint development and the leadership of cities in the fight against climate change.

Four SPARCS co-creation workshops were organised during the week of the Eurocities conference on the following topics: 1) New European Bauhaus: co-creating inclusive, aesthetic and sustainable cities; 2) Cultural sustainability – co-creating innovative and creative cities; 3) Economic Sustainability – co-creating sustainable growth in cities and 4) Social Sustainability – co-creating inclusive cities for all. Representatives from the City of Espoo led the New European Bauhaus (NEB) co-creation workshop that featured a SPARCS-based challenge ‘How to scale up local renewable energy production in the urban environment?’. In addition, a representative from VTT led the workshop on cultural sustainability under the challenge ‘How can culture, especially through citizen involvement, be an accelerator for climate neutrality in cities and metropolises?’. Project members from VTT, FHG and Espoo showcased SPARCS in the exhibition hall at a specifically dedicated stand.

SPARCS fellow city Maia took part in The European Mobility Week in September 2022, offering various recreational and interactive activities in Praça do Município. The theme of the event was centred around smooth mobility and carbon neutrality. The Mayor António Silva Tiago started the event with a bike ride together with Council members. The initiative aims to promote sustainable behaviours, raise awareness about transport's environmental impact, foster intermodality, and encourage citizens to rediscover their city in a healthier environment while highlighting the importance of reducing car usage for decarbonization, promoting social interactions, and improving overall societal happiness and equity. Additionally, a range of campaigns, safety exercises, exhibitions, and youth competitions throughout the week underscore Maia's commitment to sustainable mobility and the imminent launch of on-demand public transport services in the municipality.

During the Urbis Smart City Fair held from September 19th to 21st, 2022, the Czech Technical University in Prague (CVUT) hosted a workshop uniting four Czech follower/fellow/sandbox cities: Brno (Ruggedised), Kladno (SPARCS), Praha (Operátor ICT – OICT from CRAFT Cities), and Písek (CityxChange). The workshop centered on sharing key insights and needs among cities. It showcased Brno's stakeholder engagement in the Špitálka district redevelopment, Kladno's systemic changes through SPARCS, Praha's accumulation of lessons from EU-funded projects, and Písek's successful implementation of the Positive Energy Blocks plan. This underscored the importance of international collaborations in fostering knowledge exchange among cities, inspiring several other Czech cities attending the workshop.

Maia organised a joint meeting on October 13th, 2022, between SPARCS and two new Horizon projects, OMEGA-X and EHHUR, leading the way for the energy transition in the city. Local SPARCS partners NEW R&D, SPI, and AdEPorto are working together on the three projects to boost climate neutrality in Maia. In addition to the work done in SPARCS, The EYES HEARTS HANDS Urban Revolution (EHHUR) is developing and testing a methodology to support community involvement and co-design. OMEGA-X aims to implement a data space based on



common European standards, including a federated infrastructure, a data market and a services market.

In October 2022, SPARCS was invited to explain why Positive Energy Districts (PEDs), or simply districts that produce more energy than they consume, help cities achieve their ambitious climate goals. The SPARCS project shared critical findings at an energy-themed morning coffee event for city representatives organised by the Urban Academy. The event gathered about 70 to 80 participants from different Finnish municipalities, discussing the role of citizens in the energy transition. VTT's Dr Mari Hukkalainen, the project's coordinator, presented the role of PEDs in urban transformation in Espoo and other cities across Finland. Bringing in the concrete example of SPARCS Lighthouse City of Espoo, energy specialist Joni Mäkinen presented the municipality's goals for sustainable development by sharing how SPARCS helps the city to reach them.

The City of Reykjavík hosted Climathon, a 24-hour ideation hackathon. Orchestrated by EIT Climate-KIC and supported by the EIT, a body of the European Union, the event took place on October 28th-29th, 2022, at Vísindagarðar in Gróska, Reykjavík Science City. Its aim was to solicit innovative and sustainable ideas for mobility directly from the public. The event was led by SPARCS, an EU program led by the Office of the Mayor and CEO of the City. It is a network of 7 European cities developing Sustainable energy Positive & zero cARbon CommunitieS and tackling climate change challenges with multifaced solutions.

SPARCS joined 26 other European projects and initiatives under the umbrella of the European Commission with a shared stand branded European Smart Cities and Communities at the world's leading event for cities - Barcelona Smart City Expo World Congress from 15 to 17 November, 2022. The stand attracted more than 200 in-person participants and 3 Commission DGs for a three-day marathon presenting the progress of European Smart Cities funded through different EU funding programmes. Partners from VTT, the City of Espoo, Fraunhofer IAO, BABLE, CVUT and the city of Kladno, and GOPA Com. joined the Expo to present the progress made in SPARCS since the launch in 2019. In a special standalone booth session on Replication, Espoo, Kladno, VTT, BABLE, and Fraunhofer IAO presented why the learning system between SPARCS lighthouse and fellow cities is the critical success factor in replicating innovative solutions that help build the future of smart cities across Europe. SPARCS also presented at two of the four main agora sessions by sharing insight on the overall state of the European Smart cities and by introducing the work done on positive energy districts to its cities to achieve climate neutrality by 2030.

### 3.1.2 Year 2023

Seecon Ingenieure GmbH organized several events in 2023 within the framework of SPARCS. On February 2nd, 2023 in the neighbourhood meeting place of the LWB the film "Checker Tobi and the secret of our planet" was screened presented and pedagogically supervised. Numerous families from the neighbourhood were invited to the event and more than 40 children and adults attended. Goal of the day was to sensitize and inspire children about environmental and climate issues. On March the 3rd Seecon in cooperation with the Caritas Leipzig and Wohnen & Service Leipzig GmbH (WSL) provided tips for reducing heating costs and saving

energy and presented digital solutions for tracking and controlling energy consumption.

On April 19, 2023 SPARCS organized a webinar on the following topic: Virtual power plant as part of the future of real estate. During the webinar it was presented and discussed how virtual power plants will affect the future of real estate. Research findings and practical examples of how virtual power plants are operating in Espoo lighthouse city were presented as well.

On 20 April 2023, SPARCS organised a webinar presenting an overview of the projects most project's successful engagement actions based on the experience gained so far. SPARCS lighthouse Leipzig shared their experiences in citizen engagement and the plans to enhance working structures to speed up neutral climate development in the city. SPARCS' other lighthouse city Espoo presented the newly developed co-creation model. Research organisations Fraunhofer made a live demo of the Citizen engagement platform, while SPI gave an overview of the social empowerment and engagement tools used across SPARCS.

Eurocities' annual environment forum, themed "Powering our cities," was held in Ghent, Belgium from April 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> 2023, recognizing the pressing need for Europe to overhaul its energy production and consumption, driven not only by climate change concerns but also exacerbated by the global energy crisis stemming from Russia's invasion of Ukraine. With over 200 participants representing European cities, the forum facilitated knowledge-sharing among cities, explored European regulatory developments, and offered insights from industry representatives. On the last day of the forum, Elina Wanne shared Espoo and SPARCS learnings and experiences in collaboration as one of the city show cases e.g. co-creation model for smart and sustainable district development.

SPARCS participated in Tampere Smart City Week Expo & Conference, held on 6-7 June 2023 at Nokia Arena, Tampere, Finland. City of Espoo's SPARCS team members participated in the conference which provided interesting presentations and discussions on topical smart city themes, cases and projects, including system level development of smart cities, autonomous vehicles, prospects of artificial intelligence in cities, and the emergent planning practices of urban air mobility, among others.

Leipzig University presented research from SPARCS at the 19<sup>th</sup> edition of the International Conference on European Energy Markets (EEM) hosted by LUT University from June 6 to 8, 2023. About 250 scientists and industry experts presented and discussed their latest research in keynotes and paper sessions. Simon Johanning, Nancy Retzlaff, Hendrik Kondziella, Philipp Lerch, and Karl Specht from the University of Leipzig presented the latest findings from case studies related to SPARCS.

During the Rock for People festival in Hradec Králové, Czech Republic (8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> June 2023), CVUT engaged in a fusion of innovation and music within the festival's Sustainability zone, powered by hydrogen, courtesy of Komerční banka. Visitors were introduced to SPARCS' district-level energy solutions and energy flexibility concepts, experiencing a hands-on challenge to optimize energy consumption and navigate the electricity market.

The city of Kifissia, represented from SPARCS' local project manager Artemis Giavasoglou, participated in the final event of DECIDE: "Ways forward for collective energy actions. How everyone can be part of the energy transition", held in Brussels on 19 June. DECIDE is a H2020 project that aimed to understand how energy communities and energy efficiency services are best managed and how to best encourage participation.

The Energy in Built Environment: PED-EU-NET Lisbon Conference 2023, held at the end of June 2023, marked a significant milestone in the Positive Energy Districts (PEDs) domain, drawing over 100 participants from European countries to celebrate achievements and collaborate on key aspects like mapping, process learning, and business modelling. At the conference, SPARCS partners took a prominent role, with CVUT leading the Working Group responsible for the PED Database and initiating efforts to share lessons learned among projects through storytelling. Noteworthy contributions came from Nadja Riedel from the City of Leipzig and other panellists, discussing complex project management experiences, while SPARCS' representation extended through EDP's team from Portugal. Additionally, the meeting included discussions by the European Energy Research Alliance Joint Programme Smart Cities, wherein CVUT leads a working group aiming to facilitate applied research bridging research and practical application in smart and liveable neighbourhoods and communities.

Kladno hosted the esteemed Brownfields 2023 conference on July 18th, focusing on urban transformation and the redevelopment of former industrial sites, gathering over 200 experts from across the Czech Republic. The conference focused on strategies to revitalize brownfields. It emphasized topics such as project financing, collaborative efforts between cities and investors, regulatory frameworks for site development, and ensuring economic and environmental sustainability. The discussions highlighted Kladno's progress towards smart energy initiatives and its involvement in international projects like SPARCS.

In July 2023, a discussion seminar on the use of smart systems in the management process of cities and municipalities was held in Kladno within the Framework of the Kladno City Energy Development Platform. The seminar brought together representatives of the city, Kladno's partners in the field of "Smart City" – the cities of Prague and Písek and representatives of ICT operators as well as private technology firms that offer solutions to the public and private sectors.

On July 13th, the Maia City Council and Espaço Municipal organized the 1st Participatory Session of the Horizon Europe-supported project "EHHUR – Eyes, Hearts, Hands, Urban Revolution" at the Community Center of Vermoim and Sobreiro (CCVS). Residents demonstrated strong engagement in the rehabilitation process, set to commence in Blocks 41 and 42 by year-end under the 1<sup>o</sup> Direito program, showcasing the strategic significance of the Sobreiro neighbourhood within the SPARCS Implementation Plan for initiatives like the installation of an Energy Community and the development of an "eco-neighbourhood." The initiative received support and collaboration from partner entities, including the Porto Energy Agency (AdEPorto), EDP\_New, and the Portuguese Innovation Society (SPI), further enhancing the engagement in the EHHUR project by both the municipality and Espaço Municipal.

In a face-to-face media gathering in Helsinki on September 1st 2023, several prominent media outlets converged to discuss Finland's strides in establishing energy-positive urban zones within the SPARCS project, aligning with the European Union's ambitious targets outlined in the Paris Climate Agreement. Organized by Finnish SPARCS partners RIL, VTT, and Siemens, the media event aimed to highlight the importance of these regions in achieving climate-neutral cities and accelerating the transition to sustainable energy solutions within the built environment. This media event led to an article about implementing positive energy district solutions in Finland based on an expert interview by the SPARCS coordinator, Mari Hukkalainen to be published in a Talotekniikka magazine for built environment experts.

SPARCS participated in the +CityxChange Final Conference titled "The Future of Positive Energy Districts" on October 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> 2023, providing insights into the implementation experiences and key learnings across three pivotal themes: enabling a common energy market, fostering connected communities, and offering recommendations for policy interventions and business models. Representatives from various cities engaged in discussions and shared insights at the event, with Mari Hukkalainen from VTT presenting SPARCS' initiatives. A workshop and group discussion involving professionals from VTT, Espoo, Kladno, and Reykjavik further delved into the project's experiences and perspectives, enhancing the exchange of valuable insights and experiences.

The "Towards Sustainable Urban Environment" webinar, hosted by RIL on October 10th 2023, exclusively in Finnish, offered pioneering insights into sustainable urban development within the SPARCS project framework. The event showcased innovative strategies. Among these were the Co-creation Model Toolkit introduced by Jani Tartia from the City of Espoo. Additionally, the successful implementation of sustainable energy solutions at Lippulaiva was presented by Kimmo Hyttinen from Citycon. These highlighted the potential for cities to become hubs of innovation and ecological responsibility, aligning environmental, social, and economic goals.

Kladno's representation at the Urban Mobility Days (4 -6 October) 2023 conference in Seville, Spain, facilitated by Michal Koníček, the SPARCS Project Manager, provided invaluable insights, inspiration, and networking opportunities among the gathering of over 800 participants exploring sustainable urban mobility innovations. Addressing traffic challenges from daily commuters and local mobility issues, Kladno aims to execute projects outlined in their Implementation Plan. Notably, the city focuses on enhancing the 'E-mobility public/private & charging system.' This effort builds upon their comprehensive E-Mobility study published in 2022, emphasizing the need for improved cycling infrastructure despite being a city of short distances.

For the second consecutive year, SPARCS joined a group of 31 European Union (EU) projects at the Smart City Expo World Congress (SCEWC) from 7-9 November 2023 in Barcelona, Spain. SPARCS partners from the city of Espoo, Leipzig and Kladno joined the event alongside partners from VTT, Fraunhofer, CVUT and GOPA Com. In a dedicated session titled "Sustainable Cities Powered by Positive Energy Concepts," SPARCS, alongside POCITYF, RESPONSE, and ATELIER, spearheaded discussions on positive energy districts' pivotal role in achieving urban climate

neutrality. Additionally, Kladno's representation highlighted the city's climate initiatives during the policy congress session "Creating Irresistible Climate-Neutral Cities." The role of innovative business models in expanding the reach and impact of mobility and energy projects became the centre of the agora session titled "Scaling Up Mobility and Energy Projects with Innovative Business Models" featuring SPARCS in a panel discussion on scaling up projects alongside MAKING-CITY, ICC, and Scalable Cities.

The table below provides a fully overview of the events mapped since 2019 with updated added for 2022 and 2023. The current number of events mapped stands at 304 events. The full document with the event tracking tool is available as an annex.
